- 4. Articles must be picked up between 1:00-4:00 CT on Wednesday. Early pick up of exhibits or if the exhibits are not picked up by 4:00 CT means forfeiture of premiums. All items not picked up on time will be discarded.
- 5. The Green County KEHA members, University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Staff or the Green County Fair Board will not be responsible for any loss. Efforts will be made to prevent any losses.
- 6. Decisions of the judges are final.
- 7. Judges have the discretion of not awarding a first-place blue ribbon if the product is not of blue ribbon quality.
- 8. PLEASE READ ALL DIRECTIONS AND CATAGORIES AS SOME MIGHT HAVE CHANGED SINCE LAST YEAR! FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE RULES WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

100: FOOD PRESERVATION DIVISION

Judging Criteria: Judges look at the following to determine a quality product: appearance of pack, head space, preparation and selection of canned products. All canned items must be processed and sealed according to USDA standards. (Contact the Extension Office if you have any questions about this process, publication FCS3-325.) Paraffin may not be used. Entries must be in an approved pint or quart jar with rust free rings and lids. (Half pints for jams and jellies only.) All items must be labeled with a permanent marker directly on the lid with the name of the product and the date (month and year) when it was processed. Jars may be opened at the discretion of the judges. Only items canned during the previous year may be eligible to win a premium.
